

17% of students enrolled this Spring are minorities. There has been a steady increase since Spring 2010 - 9% of students enrolled were minorities.









Average Age by Dept., Division





Entering Average Age by Population, Dept.




History of Credit Hours

Spring credit hour production is 13,328 (this does not include Medical Assisting students). This is a 17.5% (n=1987) increase in credit hours from the prior Spring.
