The **Annual Retention Report** tracks Nebraska Methodist College (NMC) student retention rates for all programs and are reported by population, status, degrees, division, and department. The Medical Assistant (MDAS) program rates are reported individually due to unique program lengths.

### Report Glossary:

**Retention Rate:** An institutional and program measure, representation of the students who have stayed enrolled from year to year at the same institution. John Bean stated, "Retention rates are related to the interaction between the students attending the college and the characteristics of the college." We track Fall to Fall annually for the majority of the programs as well as a smaller cohort retention breakout for MDAS and NRAC.

**Persistence Rate:** A student measure, representation of a student's entire higher education journey. As long as the student continued their education, they have persisted. The institution where the student graduated will count them in their retention, the other institutions the student attended will count the student as a part of their attrition rates. We report the students that persisted within our institution (changed programs) as well as the students that enrolled in another institution.

**Department:** students that are in a Health Professions or Nursing program.

**Division:** students that are in an undergraduate or graduate program

**Populations:** students are reported by the below student populations.

Current - students that have returned to our institution. This includes students that have changed majors/tracks.

Entering Transfer - students who have transferred into our institution for the first time and previously attended another institution.

Entering FTF - students who are first time freshman at our institution and have never previously attended at another institution.

**Status:** students that are enrolled with a full time or part time status in the base term.
