



EDUCATED CITIZEN STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES RESULTS 2021-2024

Instructors assess undergraduate student achievement levels of NMC’s six Student Learning Outcomes using a wide variety of assignments throughout students’ academic experience. The established targets are as follows:

- For 100- and 200-level courses, 80% of overall rubric scores will reach at least a level 2 on a 1-4 scale.
- For 300- and 400-level courses, 80% of overall rubric scores will reach at least a level 3 on a 1-4 scale.
