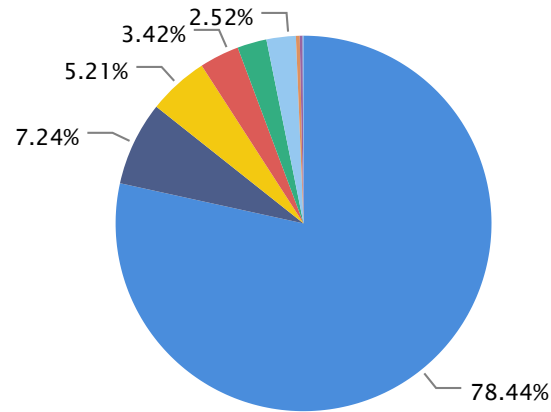

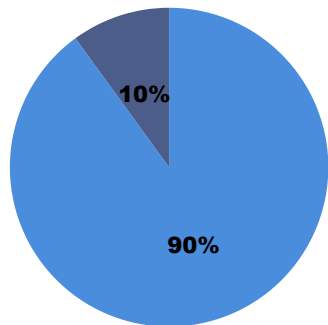

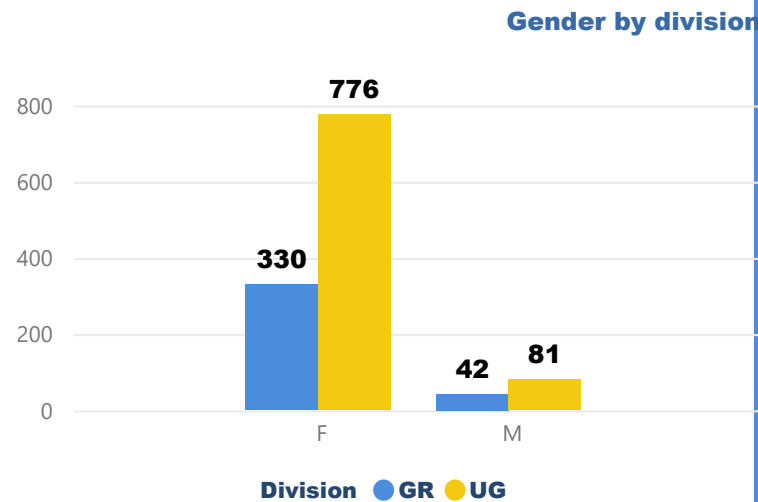
## Gender by Division

### Total Population by Gender

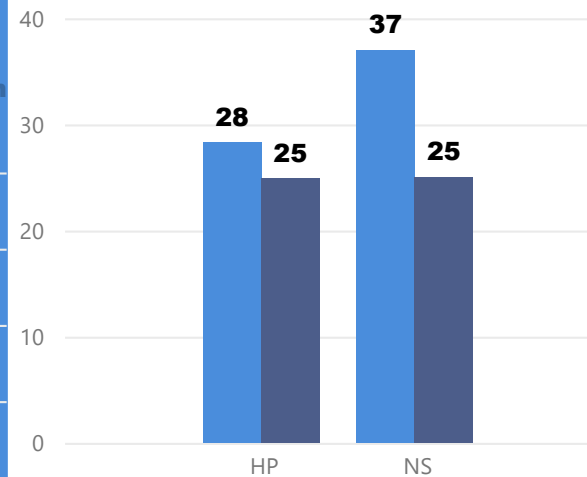

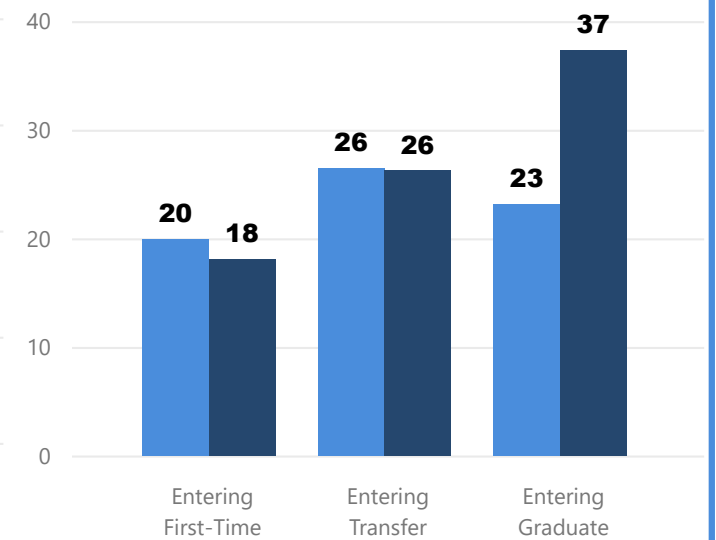
## Average Age by Dept., Division

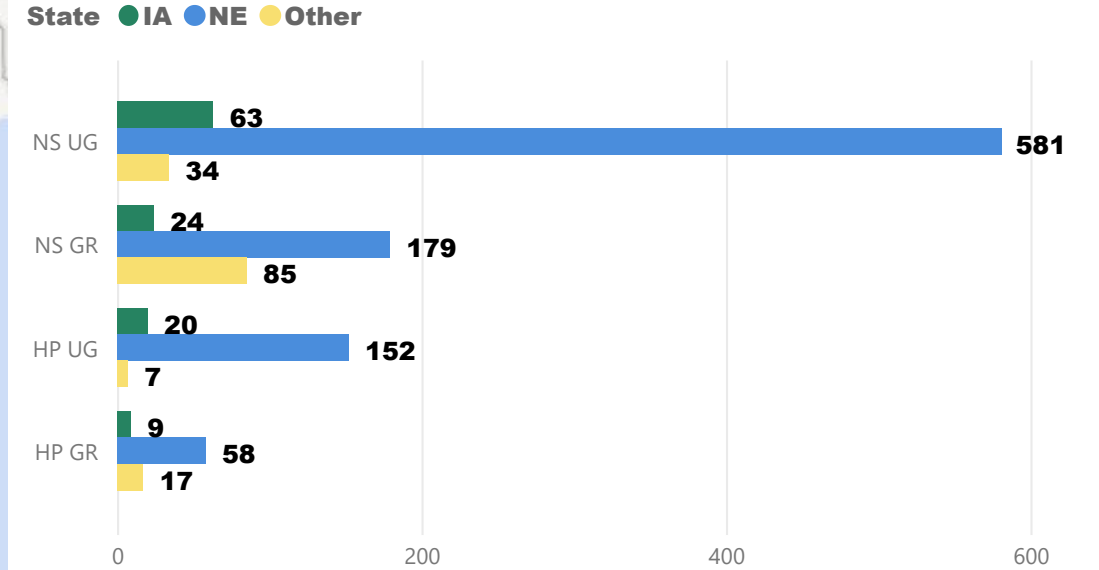
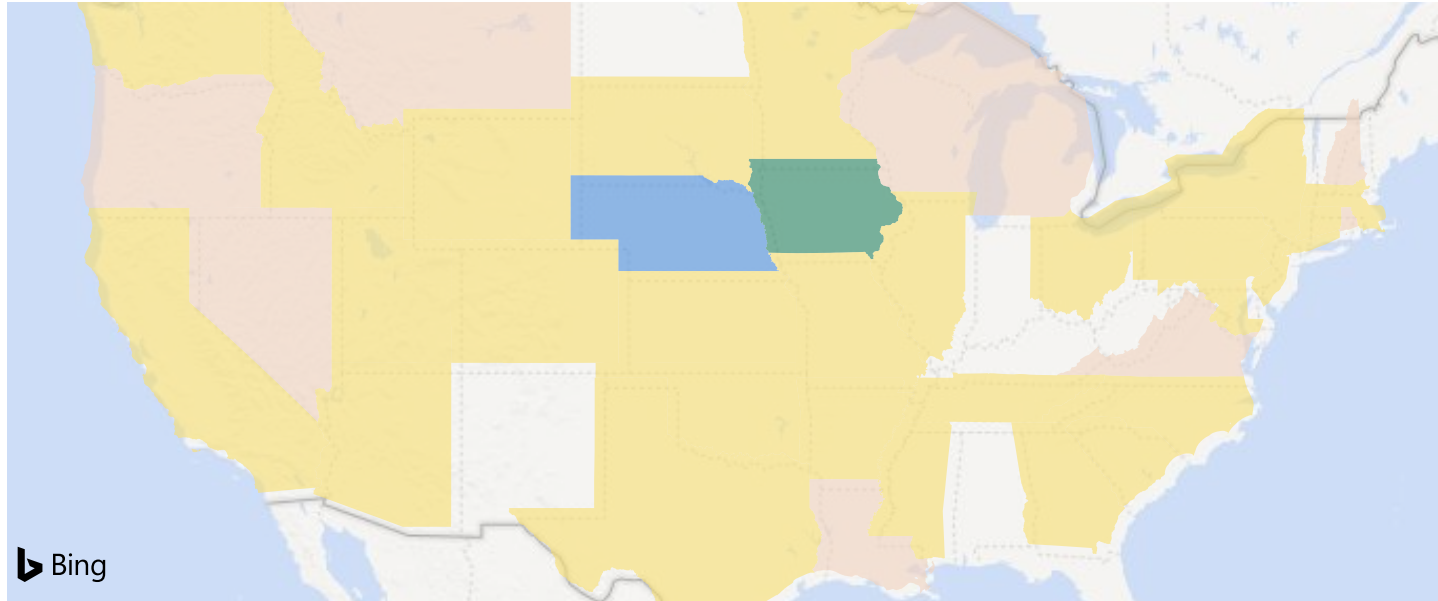


## Entering Average Age by Population, Dept.

**Federal Pell Grant Recipients:**

During the Fall 2021 semester, 29% (n=178) of fulltime undergraduate students received a Federal Pell Grant. Of these recipients, 92% were female. Female students represent 90% of the total student body. 73% of Federal Pell Grant recipients were of White/Non-Hispanic ethnicity which represents 78% of the student body.

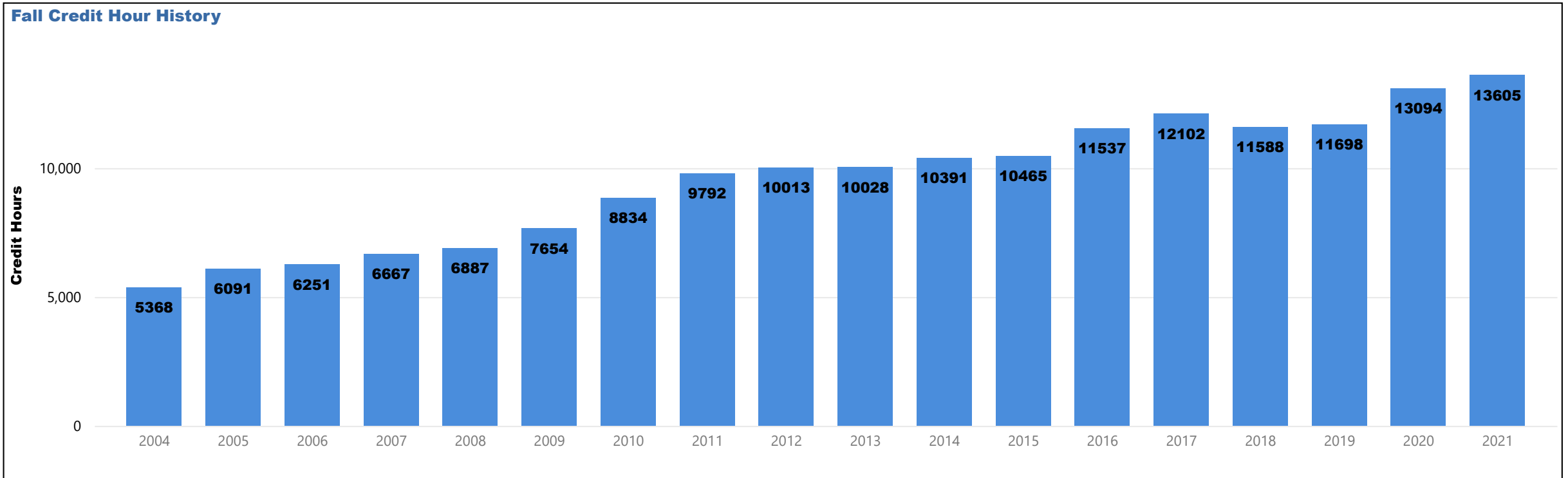
