Dear NMC Community,

Out of an abundance of caution for our students, staff and faculty, NMC's campus will remain closed for the summer semester. The health of our college community is too important to reopen at this time. We are continuing to plan for campus reopening and expect to be back on campus for the fall 2020 semester in accordance with appropriate public health measures.

Online learning will continue through the summer semester. Students—your program director will be contacting you with details specific to your academic progression in your program. Please reach out to your program director or academic advisor with questions or concerns. Student support resources remain available remotely and ready to assist. Summer clinical rotations will be completed according to individual program availability.

Employee, student or visitor access to campus will remain as it has been since April 13, 2020. Those employees previously identified as essential to continuity of NMC on campus operations; students within our campus housing; and a limited number of students and faculty approved to complete critical program requirements may continue access to campus as appropriate. All other employees or students would need appropriate Program Director and Vice President approval.
