PURPOSE:	This policy provides the requirements for undergraduate academic honors.

POLICY:

Honor Roll: Upon completion of a term, all certificate students earning a grade point average of 3.75 or above will be listed. Students with an incomplete on their semester grade report are not eligible for the list.

Dean's List: All full-time undergraduate students earning a semester grade point average of 3.75 or above will be listed. Students with an incomplete on their semester grade report are not eligible for the list.

Graduation Honors:

Graduates with an Associate Degree will be awarded honors based on cumulative grade point averages as follows:

- Highest Distinction 3.87 – or above
- Distinction 3.64 – 3.86
- Honorable Mention 3.50 – 3.63

Graduates with a Baccalaureate Degree will be awarded honors based upon cumulative grade point averages as follows:

- Summa Cum Laude 3.87 – or above
- Magna Cum Laude 3.64 – 3.86
- Cum Laude 3.50 – 3.63

Educated Citizen Honors

Graduates who complete an exemplary portfolio, including an additional critical reflection, will be awarded a Portfolio of Distinction. Graduates who are awarded the Portfolio of Distinction and the Outstanding Capstone Presentation Award are admitted into the Educated Honor Society. The Outstanding Capstone Presentation is an honor given to students whose final Capstone presentation was of exceptional quality.

Academic Travel Abroad & Educational Experience Abroad

Students participating in travel abroad courses within the fall or spring semester will receive an Incomplete for the course until the course trip and requirements are completed and therefore are not eligible for Honor's Roll or Dean's List for that semester.
